So we are both a club and a ministry. Our Patron Saint is Junipero Serra {November 24, 1713 – August 28th, 1784} a Roman Catholic Spanish Priest and friar of the Franciscan Order who founded a mission in Baja, California and the first 9 of 21 missions in California from San Diego to San Francisco. Serra was beatified by Pope John Paul II on September 25, 1988 and was canonized by Pope Francis on September 23, 2015 at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington D.C.; and Because of Serra's recorded acts of piety combined with his missionary efforts he was granted the posthumous title Apostle of California.
